### **TICKETS:**

### **HOW LONG SHOULD I PLAN TO VISIT THE EXHIBITION?**

We recommend at least two hours to visit the exhibition. Note that due to the popularity of certain works and the participatory nature of the exhibition, a waiting time should be anticipated in order to experience certain works. Please consider that some of them could be fully booked for the day. Keep this in mind when planning your visit and arrive early. Depending on traffic volume, a waiting list system may be in place for some of the works, please inquire at your arrival for further details.

### **CAN I WEAR GLASSES?**

We strongly recommend contact lenses over glasses to optimize your experience.

### **VIRTUAL REALITY AND MOTION SICKNESS:**

Persons subject to motion sickness also run the risk of feeling nauseous when using a VR headset. These visitors should pay particular attention to this warning. Much like the sensation felt after disembarking from a cruise ship, symptoms from exposure to virtual reality headsets may persist or become more intense a few hours after the experience. We recommend that visitors close their eyes or take a break as soon as they notice symptoms, and do not hesitate to consult attendants in case of discomfort.
